Meeting Purpose: Review and identify a preferred concept plan for Colorado Corridor and for Greenwood East Corridor. Review concept plans for Greenwood West.

Identify 3rd Street Preferred Crossings to move to Concept Design/Preliminary Design.

Meeting Lead: Robin Wilcox, Alta Planning + Design

Decisions made: Confirmed 3rd Street Evaluation Criteria. Confirmed selection of Hawthorne Avenue crossing and Roosevelt Avenue crossing to move forward to Concept Development.

Identified a Preferred Concept for Colorado Avenue: protected bike lane; Parkway ramps and diagonal trail crossing at signal; hold single lane further west to move forward to Concept Development.

Identified a Preferred Concept for Greenwood Avenue East: 3rd Street signal modifications; and enhanced crossings at 4th, 6th, 8th, 10th, 12th. Confirmed selection of 3rd, 4th, and 6th to move forward to Concept Development.

Discussion Items: Facility Type Crossing Guidance Table. Table provides guidance for when additional facilities may be necessary (such as median refuges, active warning beacons, and signalization) above and beyond simply marking and signing a crosswalk. Guidance is based on risk from the number of lanes crossed, traffic volumes and the speed of traffic.

Discussed Greenwood Avenue West Concept Alternatives and Preferred Alternative.

Assigned Action Items: Set up Strategy Session to review public outreach approach as project moves into Concept Development and Preliminary Design Phases. Robin Lewis send out Doodle Poll. Strategy Session to also address Greenwood West decisions.
