If you visit, live, or work in Bend, know that we are here to provide you with the very best in community policing with, **“Teamwork, Integrity, and Excellence.”**




CALLS FOR SERVICE AND FTE



■ Calls ■ Sworn ■ Non-Sworn




DISPATCHED CALLS FOR SERVICE 2016









INNOVATIVE STAFFING MODEL



Dispatched Calls YTD By Hour Of Day & Max Officers On Duty




PART ONE CRIMES* PER 1,000 PEOPLE

CITY OF BEND | Collisions per 1,000 people have remained steady over recent years.




COMMUNITY ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM

In 2017 Bend Police deployed a community enhancement program to bring the community and employees together.


