

RESOLUTION NO. 2804

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE POST EMPLOYMENT HEALTH PLAN FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYEES (PEHP) FOR ELIGIBLE NONREPRESENTED FIRE DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF BEND AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO IMPLEMENTING AGREEMENTS.

Findings

A. A Post Employment Health Plan for Public Employees has been established for eligible public employees, pursuant to section 501(c)(9) of the Internal Revenue Code permitting such plans.

B. The City of Bend wishes to contribute in a manner permitted under the Plan, on behalf of its eligible employees, portions of its employees' salary and/or accumulated compensated absences to meet its employees' post employment health care needs and expenses.

C. Under the PEHP program, Nationwide Retirement Solutions (NRS) will provide administrative services in exchange for a fee as agreed upon by the City of Bend and Nationwide Retirement Solutions.

Based on these findings,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEND RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City of Bend adopts a PEHP program on behalf of the eligible nonrepresented employees of the Fire Department of the City of Bend. The eligible employees are the Fire Department Command Staff.

2. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute, on behalf of the eligible employees of the City of Bend, a participation agreement with Nationwide Retirement Solutions, authorizing Nationwide Retirement Solutions to act as the Administrator of the Plan and the agent of the City of Bend, and other such agreements and contracts as are necessary to implement the program.


