

RESOLUTION NO. 2903

**SUPPORTING THE PASSAGE OF BALLOT MEASURE 9-93 TO CONTINUE THE FUNDING OF THE DESCHUTES COUNTY 9-1-1 SERVICE DISTRICT**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEND RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, in order to maintain funding for emergency communication services Deschutes County proposes to establish a five year local option levy at the rate of \$0.20/\$1,000 assessed value to provide emergency communications services; and

WHEREAS, the CITY OF BEND finds that the funding of the District at the proposed level is in the best interest of the citizens; now, therefore;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEND, as follows:

That the City Council of the City of Bend hereby supports the passage of ballot measure 9-93 to continue the funding of the Deschutes County 9-1-1 Service District at the rate of \$0.20/\$1,000 of assessed value.




