

ORDINANCE NO. NS-2211

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BEND CODE BY ADDING A NEW SECTION
14.90.090 SURFACE WATER WITHDRAWALS

Findings

- A. The City Council has adopted a resolution, stating council's policy and committing to the limitation in the Forest Service Environmental Assessment to an instantaneous rate from the City's Bridge Creek point of diversion to a maximum of 18.2 cubic feet per second (cfs).
- B. To increase the enforceability of that restriction, the Council is adopting this ordinance to include the 18.2 cfs limitation as part of the Bend Code.

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY OF BEND ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Bend Code is amended by adding a new Section 14.10.090 to read as follows:


14.10.090. Surface Water Withdrawals. The City water system uses both surface water and groundwater. The instantaneous rate allowed from the Bridge Creek point of diversion, shall be limited to the demand for municipal use, up to a maximum of 18.2 cubic feet per second.

Section 2. All other portions of the Bend Code shall remain in effect.


