

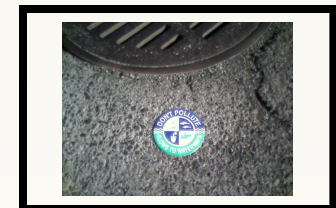
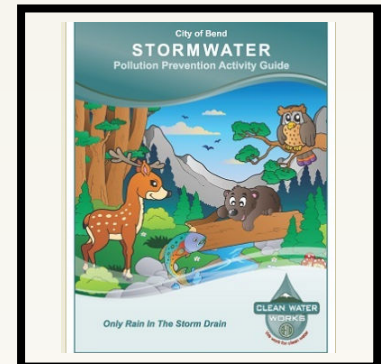
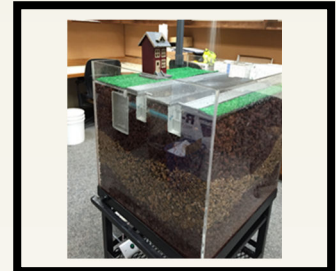

The City's Stormwater Program has resources free for your use. They include:

- **Tabletop Watershed Diorama**
– Hands on teaching tool for how water moves through a watershed; can be used to explore stormwater and groundwater pollution and pollution prevention techniques.
- **Full Size Underground Injection Control Model** –Working model of how stormwater is injected underground towards groundwater supplies.
