

RESOLUTION NO. 3067

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2017 CITY OF BEND DOWNTOWN STRATEGIC PARKING MANAGEMENT PLAN

FINDINGS

- A. In October 2015 the City Council directed the initiation of a public process to assess and optimize Bend's public parking resources. The process would include studies and would occur in three phases: downtown, city-wide, and Galveston Avenue/Century Drive.
- B. For the first phase, the process included formation of the Downtown Stakeholder Advisory Committee (DSAC), which met ten times over the course of 19 months.
- C. The DSAC was assembled and intended to represent a variety of perspectives, including downtown residents and employees, downtown business and property owners, other community members, and representatives of the Old Bend and River West neighborhood associations.
- D. In April 2016, the guiding principles for the study, developed by the DSAC, were presented to and approved by the City Council.
- E. Consistent with the guiding principles, data collection occurred in spring and summer 2016.
- F. In April 2017, the implementation strategies informed by the data collection were presented to and approved by the City Council.
- G. The Downtown Strategic Parking Management Plan (Plan) is the result of this process, the guiding principles, collected data, implementation strategies, and the extensive work, input, and process guided by the Council and the DSAC.
- H. The Plan contains recommendations including, among other things, infrastructure upgrades, operations initiatives, creation of a Parking Demand Manager position, possible fee changes, refinement and adjustment of parking management zones and parking permit programs, updating data and other performance metrics, and other recommendations, strategies, and actions.

Based on these findings, the City of Bend resolves as follows:

1. The City Council supports and adopts the 2017 City of Bend Downtown Strategic Parking Management Plan and its goals, strategies, and recommendations.

2. The City Council directs staff to take appropriate action to implement and advance the goals, strategies, and recommendations reflected in the Plan.


