The Bend Urban Renewal Agency (BURA) Board is looking for interested citizens to fill thirteen positions on the [Urban Renewal Advisory Board](#). Applicants must be residents of City of Bend. The Advisory Board will provide recommendations to BURA relating to the potential use of urban renewal for the central area of Bend to accomplish the goals and policies outlined in the Bend Comprehensive Plan.

The Advisory Board will meet monthly over the next two years while a new Urban Renewal Feasibility Study is completed. The BURA Board is specifically looking for individuals who represent the following stakeholder groups:

- Local developer with long term interest in the central area of Bend
- A (former) member of the UGB Steering committee
- Multi-modal transportation professional
- Business owner inside the feasibility study area
- Resident inside the feasibility study area or a representative nominated by a Neighborhood Association
- Builder – Multi-family and/or Mixed Use
- Residential and commercial financing professional
- Social Service organization representative
- Cascades East Transit representative or a transit dependent resident
- Four at-large community members
