

# PARKING UPDATES Effective Jan. 1, 2019

Change is coming! The City of Bend, Downtown Bend Business Association and the Downtown Parking Advisory Committee are working together to improve parking downtown.

*The goal is to make parking **easy, available and safe.***



## EXTENDED ENFORCEMENT HOURS

To improve the availability of customer parking in the evening downtown, enforcement hours are being extended from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. This will be in effect for the downtown core, which is bounded by Greenwood to the North, Lava and Harriman to the East, Franklin to the South and Drake Park to the West.

### NEW HOURS

8 a.m. to 7 p.m.



## RATE CHANGES

To make parking more affordable for everyone, and maximize parking opportunities, new parking permit rate changes will be taking effect.


