2019 Bend Airport Master Plan Overview

The Bend Municipal Airport is one of the busiest general aviation airports in Oregon with annual operations that are approaching 140,000 per year. The airport's rapid growth paired with the recent completion of important development projects has lead the FAA to require that the City conduct an update to the 2013 Airport Master Plan. The new plan will give the City and users the opportunity to plan for the next 20 years at the airport. Critical considerations include a runway extension, air traffic control tower, additional hangar development areas, airport access and parking, and other facility needs at the airport.

Regional Stakeholder Meetings

As part of the Bend Airport Master Plan Update the planning team will conduct two Regional Stakeholder Meetings with a select group of regional stakeholders to help build a better understanding of the role of the Bend Municipal Airport and discuss strategies and actions the Airport and Community may pursue to implement the plan when completed.

Regional Stakeholder Meeting #2


