

- **Goal #3** – Make riding easy and comfortable w/improved stop amenities/info/TDM
- **Goal #4** – Enhance transit option to provide a time/cost competitive alternative to traveling by automobile
- **Goal #5** – Evaluate emerging technologies and transit service models and how they might be used to support transportation options in Central Oregon






Bend Service - Expanded Service Area Priorities




Coverage Priorities


Public: 43 participants have signed up for Deschutes County Committee
