## City of Bend Sewer "Neighborhood Sewer Extension Program"

A Septic Authorization form, separate from this form, is required to maintain an existing septic system. Property owner shall obtain septic repair/replacement permits through Deschutes County permits.

This form is intended to be used for the Neighborhood Sewer Extension Programs. These projects are a series of City funded project for the purpose of extending public sewer mains into neighborhoods currently on septic. Affected properties along these publicly funded sewer extension projects will receive a Notice of Operational Completion (NOC) when the sewer is operational and available for connection. The property owner, to make connection to the sewer, are characterized under the following three program types:

1. The property is adjacent to the Southeast Interceptor (SEI). Per the NOC, starting on March 15, 2019, the property owner has 2 years (March 15, 2021) to connect with no connection fee. After 2 years, the connection fee increases to full price.
2. The property is adjacent to the extended sewer main and the property owner signed the application to be part of the extension program. If connection is made within the first 2 years of the NOC, the connection fee is half the full connection fee at the time of public permit. If connection is made after the NOC 2 year deadline the property owner must connect at full connection cost. Additionally, the property must connect within 2 years or face additional fines.
3. The property is adjacent to a sewer main that has been extended to the property and has not signed the application to be part of the extension program. Connection fee is half off for the first 2-years from NOC. Connection fees increased to full price after the 2 years.

System Development Charges (SDC's), and all private permit fees and costs, are in addition to the connection fee. SDC fees are not reduced.

This form must accompany the submittal for plumbing permit submittal with the Building Safety Division.
