

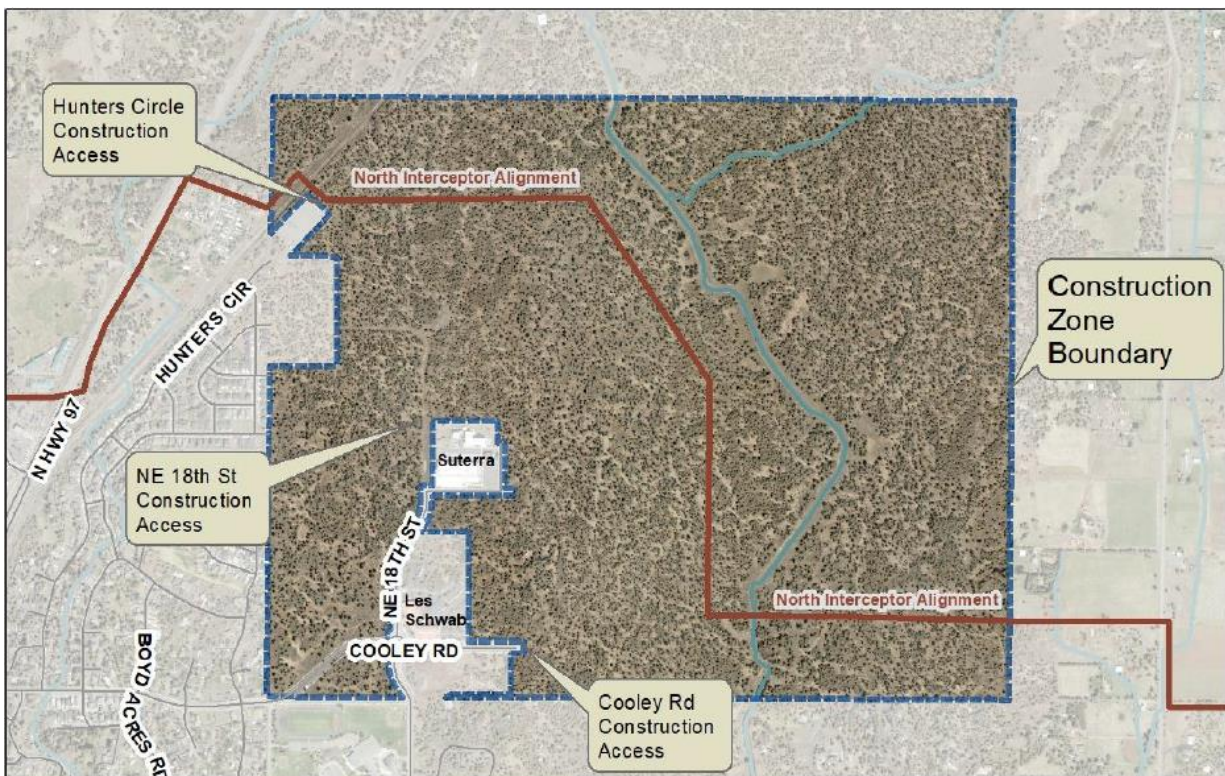
NORTH INTERCEPTOR SEWER LINE PROJECT NOTICE OF DESIGN ACTIVITIES



JANUARY 9, 2020

Please be advised that design activities for the North Interceptor Sewer Line Project are anticipated on the City-owned Juniper Ridge property during the months of January – April 2020. Activities include project personnel walking or driving the property to evaluate the existing topography and placing survey stakes/markings for project reference points, which is required to finalize the design of the project. In general, project work hours are Monday through Friday, from 7 a.m. – 6 p.m., and design activities on the property will be intermittent during this time. During these activities, existing campsites will not be disturbed, however people may see project personnel on the property conducting this work. While the intent is to minimize disruptions, we thank you in advance for your patience during these activities.

The North Interceptor Sewer Line Project is an important project that will help the City of Bend meet anticipated sewer demands. The large diameter sewer transmission line for Bend's north side will allow the City to decommission pump stations, increase sewer capacity, and provide sewer service to both developed and undeveloped lands. The map below shows the general area of the North Interceptor Sewer Line through Juniper Ridge. Future notice will be given prior to the start of construction activities.
