




**JUNIPER RIDGE  
COMMUNITY CLEANUP EFFORTS  
NOVEMBER 2019**



- A communication document was developed on the planned pre/construction scheduled and cleanup efforts at Juniper Ridge for those in and around the construction zone and other interested parties that included an FAQ and a list of social service agencies.
  - This was released and widely distributed on November 15, 2019 to multiple agencies.
  - This was widely distributed to campsites established at Juniper Ridge the week of November 18, 2019.






- Cleanup efforts for the removal of debris from Juniper Ridge was done in partnership with the City of Bend Streets and Operations Department and Deschutes County Sheriff's Office (DCSO) Inmate Work Crew Program during the week of November 18, 2019.



# CLEANUP EFFORTS: NOV 18 – 21, 2019



- 1,500 acres were canvassed by vehicle and by foot.
- 16 concentrations of debris were identified.
- 75,580 lbs. of debris were removed.
- 15 trips were made to the landfill.



# REMOVAL EFFORTS



**552 Labor Hours.**

**29,500 Labor Dollars.**

**28 Crew Members.**



- Approximately 552 labor hours and 29,500 labor dollars were consumed by this effort.
  - City of Bend Facilities Department: 32 Hours
  - City of Bend Streets and Operations Department: 200 Hours
  - DCSO: 64 Hours
  - DCSO Inmate Work Crew Program: 256 Hours
- Other expenses incurred totaling \$10,800:
  - Rental of bins: \$1,000
  - Disposal Fees: \$1,750
  - Use of Equipment: \$7,500





- 1,500 acres were canvassed
- 16 piles of debris identified
- 75,580 lbs. of debris were removed
- 15 trips to the landfill
- 4 days to complete
- 28 crew members
- 552 labor hours
- 29,500 labor dollars
- \$10,800 in fees and hard costs
  
- \$40,300 overall cost
