# REMOBILIZATION PLAN

Health Services is following a 5 phase approach for remobilizing into our buildings.

We are currently in Stage 2 with access to public buildings having been restored.

Stage 5 is fully staffed and complete services levels.

## DCSC OPENING

Soft opening June 1<sup>st</sup> with limited hours and staffing.  
Monday – Friday 7 am to 5 pm.

Currently hiring all expanded hours and weekend staff.

Planning to expand hours to 7 days a week until 9 pm by August.

Full array of services will not be available until stage 4-5 of our remobilization plan.

## FUNDING

IMPACTS grant (SB 973) – 10 million for the State.  
Unknown number or amount of awards.

Applying for funding to operate 24/7 for 2 years. Grant begins in July.

State budget shortfall could impact this grant.

## FUNDING CONTINUED...

COHC funding will end June 30, 2021.

If we are not awarded the IMPACTS grant, the DCSC will only be able to operate Monday – Friday 7-5 after June 2021.

Ongoing community partner funding will be necessary in order to expand hours and include weekends.
