

**RESOLUTION NO. 134**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING A SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET FOR THE 2019-2021 BIENNIAL BUDGET PERIOD BEGINNING JULY 1, 2019.**

THE BOARD OF THE BEND URBAN RENEWAL AGENCY (BURA) RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. In accordance with ORS 294.473, the proposed supplemental budget will provide for appropriation adjustments that were not anticipated when the 2019-2021 Biennial Budget was developed. A public hearing is required because fund expenditures will be adjusted by more than 10%. In accordance with ORS 294.473, public notice that a supplemental budget will be considered is required, and this notice was published on or before August 26, 2020.



Adopted by a vote of the Bend Urban Renewal Agency on August 31, 2020.


