FORCE IS THE APPLICATION OF PHYSICAL TECHNIQUES TO ANOTHER PERSON WHO IS RESISTING.


MULTIPLE FORCE APPLICATIONS CAN OCCUR IN A SINGLE FORCE EVENT.


